HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR NEOPRENE MASK

- Store masks in such a way as to avoid their becoming misshapen.
- Do not store masks with painted surfaces touching (ideally place masks in a fabric bag if stored in a box with other masks).
- As much as possible, keep masks out of extreme temperature conditions
- Avoid bending the masks to the point of cracking the neoprene
- If straps are too long fold in center and pin or sew.
- Wigs and hats can be sewn to the neoprene
- To sanitize masks you can use Lysol disinfectant wipes with the anti flu virus label. The masks can be also be sanitized with rubbing alcohol, a solution of 1/3 hydrogen peroxide to 2/3 water sprayed and wiped off, or baby wipes. The black back paint may be removed by the sanitization of the masks and can be reapplied as necessary. Use any black acrylic paint.
- Avoid backing over the masks with your car.
